- The meeting was called to order by President Jackie Pfursich.
- The meeting proceeded according to the agenda set by the President.

**II. Coach & Liaison Reports**

**A. Girls –**

We may have to see how we handle with tournaments and events because a lot of the high school girls tournaments, which double dipped with middle school. So now it's a scramble to try to find something for the middle school, but yet it's not really approved for the school, so it's kind of like where in that limbo area. We're going to run into one little snag It would be January 31st when I go up to Williamsport, and it's also the JH E-town Optimus Championships. So Kevin and I have already said, Since Fiona will be at E-Town, Kevin will stay here and take care of E town, and Al will go up to Williamsport with the other assistant coach.

- B. Youth –** Registration has soft closed. We are in the mid 150s in registration right now. We've got about 40 Novice, approaching 30 in the Resilience room, another 15 in Grit, and Als Girls are at 30. We've collected about \$19,000 to date which includes some prepaid raffle tickets. Rooms are set, rooms are scheduled, facilities are scheduled, practice kicks off next week 6:30 to 8 Monday through Thursday. We have head coaches for the individual rooms. Hackenberg will run the youngest group again this year. Bollinger and Maron will be co-head coaches in the Perseverance room. Resilience and Grit, Beckman is the head of both of those rooms, Kevin helping out with the advance room. We are gonna order singlets. Picture day November, 24th, it's going to be the girls grit and Resilience. We are going to try to schedule youth night and potentially have some dual's going alongside of junior high at our Solanco match January 21. Youth parent meeting is November 13 at 7 PM in person or on Zoom. All head coaches will be present to do their own introductions to start them talking to the parents. It will also be recorded and posted to the rooms in the media file.

- C. Junior High – certifications were done. The roster is around 60 but trickles down a bitter start. Jr High needs approx. 30 singlets.
- D. High School - Hired a new coach, Mike Cutullo. He wrestled at West Virginia, assistant coach at F&M, assistant coach in Millersville and at the University of Maryland. Finished our weight certifications. Finishing up the roster we lost a few to football injuries. One thing we need to make sure we have ready for matches is music since we canceled the DJ. Reaching out to the AV club about just getting a speaker at least is all we really need. We need a live score that is entering the scores into track as it's going. Addison Horner is our wrestling manager. Senior list have to be able to Jackie ASAP as the metal hangers need to be ordered immediately if we are going to bump up senior night. There's a discussion about switching of the senior gift, but a decision has to be made by the first week of December. Going forward after this year we are going to consider doing a different senior gift.

**III. Treasurer's Report – additional details to be provided at the meeting**

A. Account Balance - \$ 4603

The clinic that was held, we brought in, 1,150, and then paid out \$1,000 for the coach and then the.. So we basically covered our side with the pizza we pretty much broke even. We collected \$900 for lifting, and \$113 for merch. We're going to have to have CPWA lead dues coming out shortly it went up by \$50.

C. Black Knight Tournament - We had a talked metal swords, but that didn't work, so we got to reach out to the guy about doing something similar they need engraved. We want to do T-shirts for the champions and maybe find a sponsor. As of right now, it is Hempfield and six other teams. Beckman is going to try to get Solanco on board so it'll make it eight teams. That way, we can do two pools of four. If we only end up with seven, we will do a round robin style.

D. Program - We had to use one of the people from the vendor to help us organize it and put it together at a cost it is it \$80 per hour. So they are going to try to do it between four and six hours because we don't have anyone that is experienced with it the program. We're still working on ads.

**V. FUNDRAISING**

A. Raffle tickets – are in. Bob is having anyone who prepaid for youth getting

them their tickets as soon as possible. Before the high school or junior high gets their invoices, the TeamSnap roster has to be cleaned up so each child only has one profile and is only getting invoiced one time. The invoices for the raffle tickets will not come out until after the launch a thon.

- B. Launch a thon – High school will be December 1 right after pictures. We need to get a date for junior high as we need to reserve the room and usually need about 30 days notice. We are going to do a price structure this year, simple things like every donation they get a piece of candy and then once they hit about \$150 they get a bag of chips. Then the prices go up from there at the different milestones monetarily. Also prizes for the highest donation and the most donations.
