January 7, 2026

-The meeting was called to order by President Jackie Pfursich.

-The meeting proceeded according to the agenda set by the President.

II. Coach & Liaison Reports

- A. Girls –Good representation at CPWA Girls Championships. 2 champions. Mia Olin and Abigail Clarke (Moved up to Grit/ Resilience room paid off) Brooklyn Anderson & Hailey Tollekesn finished 3rd. Two girls finished first at the rescheduled Cumberland Valley "Wrestle for the ring". 2 champions. Lilian Reinhold & Ashlynn Arnold. Junior High Girls, one Champion- 2x Fiona Cote. Keeghan Szalcyk finished second earning her first career win in the tournament. Avenging an earlier loss in the season. Ella Pfursich finished third in a very competitive weight class. Elyse Dolhoffer finished 6th for her first campaign.
- B. Youth – CPWAs went really well. We had 6 finalist in the open division. They did not keep team scores, but when Beckman tallied, we would've ended up as team champions. Two champs and the third one was very close. If we carry that performance into PJW's, we have a few guys that have a very good shot of states. Busy weekend coming up Keystone on Saturday PJW's on Sunday. We went 14-2 as a dual team. Skating party will be Thursday, March 5th. Banquet will be held on March 28th.
- C. Junior High – Another solid year 16–2. Should be pretty solid next year just missing a few heavier weights. The season banquet we are going to do the Nook March 3. They weigh the rental fee and we are charging the parents \$15 which get you a box lunch they get a choice of Italian turkey or girls, zucchini, chips, and bottle of water. The reason for doing it this way this year is in prior years people sign up. I don't show up and we end up with a lot of leftovers. The awards will be MVP, team, most improved, hammer and hardest worker.

- D. High School - Regular season 10-2, second in other section and 10-3 overall. We mean the district appearance for the first time in a couple years. We had a tough match against Wilson. They were the 6th seed but ended up taking 2nd overall. LL Leagues replaced 7th as a team and 6 placers. Sectionals coming up this Saturday. We had the JV tournament this past week. We had 9 wrestlers, 6 placers and 3 champs. It was a good event for JV to get some experience. We lose one starter next year, DeShawn.

III. Treasurer's Report –

- A. Account Balance - \$ 32,381

There's a deposit not included of 10,381 which will take us two \$42,730. Bob just handed over at least 2000. There's a couple expenses still outstanding smaller checks and this biggest check is for the custodians. They did reduce the hours for 42 to 33 for the custodians. The new outdoor lights have been accounted . The goal is to sit around 40,000 for the end of the season so when the rental of the barn (11,000) and the budget for the end of the year stuff comes out (9,000-10,000). We can go into the Summer sitting around 20,000 to think about credits for clubs. We are at Nauman, LAW, Stellar York and we need to look into creating an account with Stellar Reading. It is very similar to Nauman. There is a drop in code and they will keep track of our credits. One thing we need to think about going into next season is budgeting the overnight for the girls. The other thing that needs to be talked about is offering the lifting sessions to the girls as well. Regional qualifier we grossed \$7,600 putting our net around \$5,000.00
