II. Coach & Liaison Reports

- A. Girls –The end of the season banquet for the junior high and high school girls will be on March 18. The elementary banquet will be in April. Fiona Cote placed seventh at PJW's. Other than that, we're just letting the girls heal up and then we'll get them back into the routine again.
- B. Youth – We are in the postseason. Practices are ongoing. Pretty active room, generally through the weeks. We have a number of wrestlers from various schools in the room. So, good competition.. Keystones are this weekend. PJWs will be 2 weekends following that. Good season. I think overall. I haven't heard any complaints or negative comments from any of the parents. Everybody seems to be thrilled, another successful season. The skating party went well great attendance, lots of junior high kids. The banquet is currently scheduled for the weekend of April 12. We are waiting confirmation from the church before I put that formally into the calendar on Team Snap.
- C. Junior High – They had their banquet. It was pretty well attended. They changed up this year. I went to the Nook. The only thing Nate brought a projector, and it was just hard to see the pictures. It was a nice presentation that he did, and there was a good amount of kids there.
- D. High School - Just had states we had three wrestlers there, Brady, Joey, Gavin. Brady was a late addition because someone got hurt in his weight class. We had a couple wins and it was a great experience. It is something to build on for next year. We also had our interviews and leave the new mats down with the kids yesterday and now we will open the clubs to everyone and go from there. We should have the new mats for 1 to 2 years. We have 6 junior high/ high school kids wrestling at Keystones this weekend, Adam Sismet, Toma

Cox, Mike Hernandez, Maximus Switzenberg, Matt Castillo and Caleb Hoosier. Lifting will begin for spring and we will keep it at \$100 for each season. Everyone on the team sold raffle tickets. We are working on a banquet date at the moment.

III. **Treasurer's Report –**

- A. Account Balance - \$39,654
- B. There are still large items that need to be paid. We need to pay Nate for the junior high banquet. The other banquets are still open so we're gonna wait for that to get a total. We need to start thinking about the overnights for the high school boys and girls. Over Covid we went from four wrestlers per room 2. So we should definitely have a discussion that if we are adding an overnight for the girls we may need to start thinking about switching back to the four per room. Economically Airbnb may make sense, but then you run into potential problems with Coaches and managers being there. Also, King in the Mountain area they're probably is not too much, especially in December. As far as Hotel, it was brought up by Coach Rush that there may be a potential if we had more than two kids per room with sometimes it's hard to sleep in a hotel room, nerves, etc it's probably best to keep one kid per bed. Ultimately is up to Shane. Coach Deck also brought up a great point that if we have an Airbnb and a handful of kids get knocked out Friday they can get a little bit more rowdy when the kids that are still in it trying are to sleep. We have to think about some pushback on the school to pay for at least one of our overnights since they pay for none of them. We need to look into what they budget for other sports such as basketball, baseball is getting a new field, etc. They don't do anything for us no warm-ups nothing. We even paid out for our own gas this year approximately \$500. The head coaches needs to talk to Landis about budget and expenses. A budget line item that we were going to need to think about next year is we host the CPWA qualifier and we will not be able to do that next year as the gym will be under construction. We have to think about possibly using the Nook. Possibly even doing our own tournament at the Nook. We will lose out on concessions at the nook, but we can look into game of chance 50/50. If we need to subsidize the money from concessions, we can go back to the chicken barbecue again.

IV. **FUNDRAISING**

- A. Raffle tickets – Final tally is \$20,660 collected, so above, far above what we've done in previous years. It was roughly \$7000 between payouts and printed tickets. Koser was generous enough to give back the \$2000 he won. We would like to do \$100 gift card to the highest seller just as a thank you.

V. **NEW/UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

A. Board Spots - Next month Jackie will get something together for the potential new board members with the help of Amber to get that vote to go out. There are a couple who are not gonna seek reelection. Justin, Myers, and the Williams. So we do have a couple spots.
